When I started at Fyfe in 1984, the company consisted of a handful of employees providing survey services in the property sector. Computers were new, floppy disks were considered modern, and the company's first hard-disk drive was a significant investment.

As my work within the company evolved — moving from manual drafting to building our computer systems, then leading the oil and gas division before becoming Managing Director and now Executive Chairman - I had a first-hand view of the company's own evolution.

There was a significant shift in 1986 when Geoffrey Allen joined Fyfe as a Director. The company started taking on larger development projects for top-tier clients. Successful outcomes helped develop our professional relationships with these clients, many of whom we've been working with ever since - that's decades of collaboration.


In the 90s, Fyfe began extending its work in the energy sector, opening offices in Moomba and Ballera and onboarding specialist engineers to help with upstream gas projects. Having a combination of pipeline experts, surveyors and engineering design people working together gave us a competitive edge; we offered something other consultancies couldn't and in the early 2000s opened an office in Brisbane to meet demand for our services.


Fyfe started doing more in the planning and infrastructure area too, eventually working on major government and private sector contracts, a move that helped us build integrated services in a number of sectors. 
In 1999, there were three Fyfe offices, but as our project opportunities around Australia progressed, we needed more people and more offices in growth areas, both in the capitals

We also increased our work in infrastructure and property development, which led us to continue growing in Adelaide and South Australia. Fyfe's ambitions to grow the business in locations across Australia saw us expanding through acquisitions in Darwin in 2008, followed by Perth in 2013.



Providing services to the property and infrastructure industries are at the core of what Fyfe was originally set up for, and it remains a key sector for us today.

In the early days, we primarily handled surveying and a handful of the infrastructure tasks that go hand in hand with property development. As Fyfe grew, both in size and geographically, we also grew our planning and engineering capabilities.

Back in 2001, the South Australian civil engineering business Allan Gilbert & Associates joined Fvfe. From there, our engineering services continued to expand, and in 2013 the structural engineering firm Trevor John & Associates joined Fyfe. From smaller development projects to major infrastructure and facility projects, the roads we've travelled to get to this point have been numerous, but it's all testament to our experience over the years.

Under Joel Stevenson, our General Manager for Property and Infrastructure, the scope and complexity of the land development, infrastructure, and transport projects we can undertake has grown. Fyfe has advised state and local governments in South Australia, Victoria and the Northern Territory, helped create modern

recreation facilities, and liaised with government bodies to deliver on large-scale projects. We've even dipped our toes into water-park planning.

Sparking change and growing our service offerings is something we do well at Fyfe. Just ask our electrical experts who, as of this year, hold the certifications needed to complete full electrical designs for new subdivisions.

Fyfe's environmental team is on hand when clients need a complete solution. With environmental scientists, ecologists, engineers, hydrogeologists, contamination experts, and specialists who know the ins and outs of compliance and due diligence. Fyfe provides a truly customised environmental service, whether it be in environmental planning and approvals, ecological studies or site contamination services.

With many of Australia's finest environmental minds on the team, we support our clients with state and federal statutory and regulatory requirements, keeping the wheels turning on complex projects and sensitive environmental challenges, often related to contaminated land.

Site contamination exits in all industrialised cities across the world, and it has been estimated that there are 160,000 polluted sites in Australia, most of which relate to historical practices. Fyfe is routinely engaged by site operators, property developers and regulators to conduct site contamination investigations of soil, groundwater, and soil vapour to determine the nature and extent of contamination and any risk it may pose to human health or the environment. Should potential risks be identified. Fyfe is engaged to remediate or mitigate these through various physical, chemical, or biological techniques.

We've been working in this field since 2013, and we're proud to have grown our environmental solutions over the years. In 2019, Fyfe expanded its environmental service offerings even further when Victorian firm, Monarc Environmental, joined the company.

Today, Fyfe's environmental offerings are a go-to for clients who also need support with documentation or services that run from hydrogeological and geochemistry assessments through to remediation management and streamlining the sign-off of statutory and regulatory projects.
